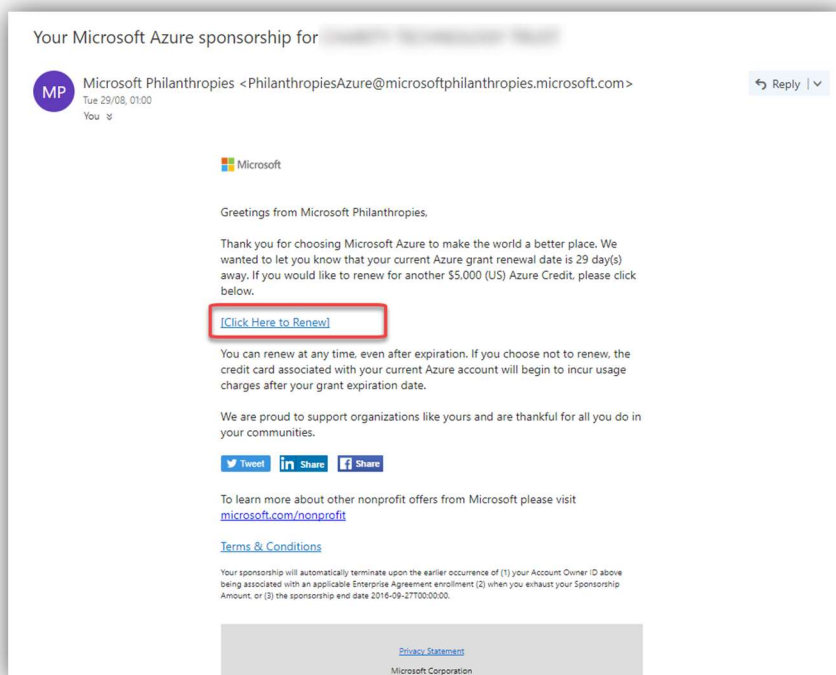




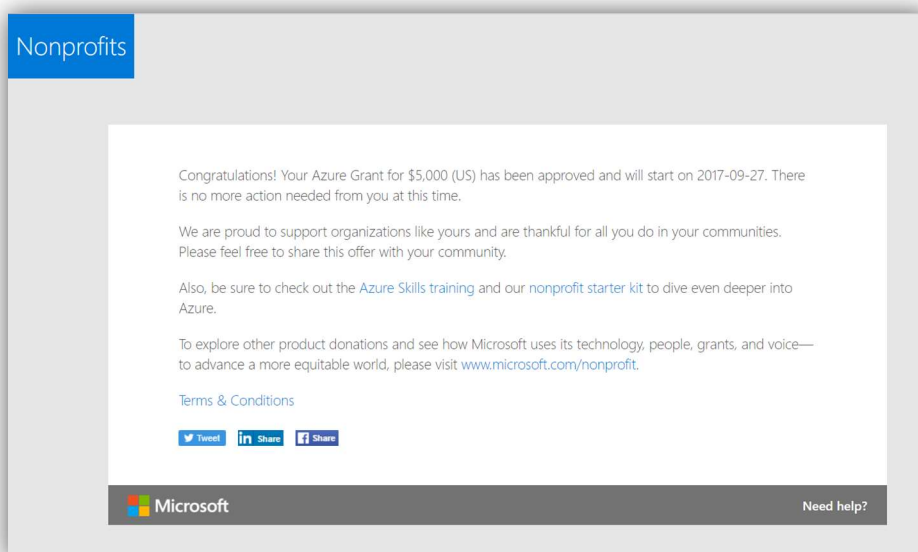
Microsoft Azure for Non-profits (Sponsorship) renewal process

If you want to renew Microsoft's Sponsorship you need to click on the link "[Click Here to Renew](#)"

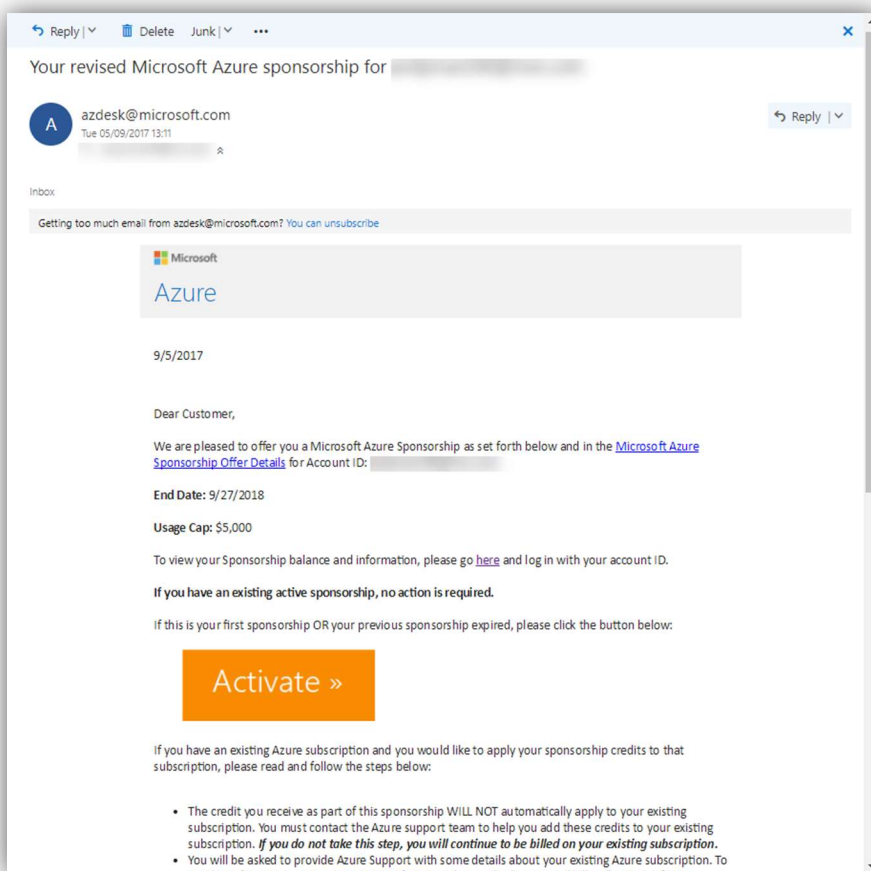
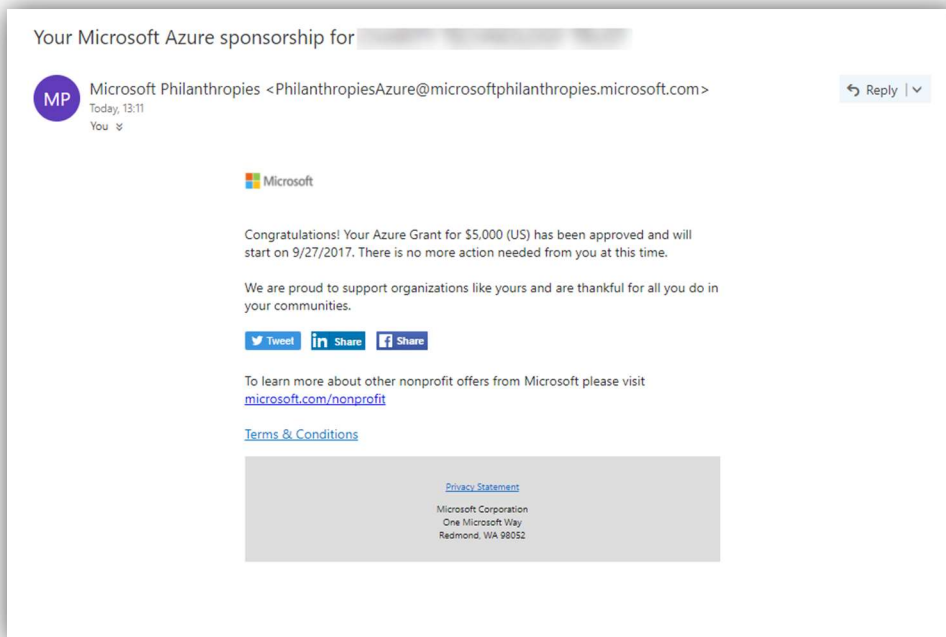


This will bring you to a website and will confirm your Microsoft sponsorship renewal.
